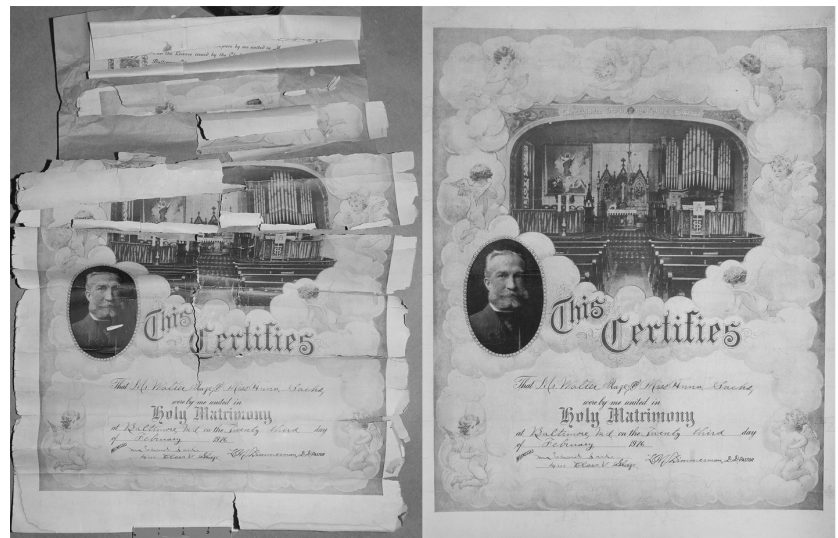

Cathy is a graduate of the York Academy of Arts' fine art program. Self employed for many years, she designed and created both commercial and residential murals. Stone has a 20-year connection with the Carlisle Arts Learning Center as teacher and staff, and has spent the last 6 years as Gallery Coordinator. As an artist, she works in acrylic, collage, and mixed media.

She earned her master's degree in Fine Arts and Paper Conservation from the Nicolas Copernicus University of Torun, Poland in 1974, and regularly offers advice on treatment options to museums across the country.

## FCAA Annual Exhibit

The Alliance's **47th annual membership show** will be held June 1-7 at Calvary United Methodist Church, 150 Norlo Drive, Fayetteville, with our opening reception Sunday June 3, 2-5 PM, and show hours continuing Mon.-Thurs. June 4-7, 2-7 PM. Entries must be mailed by Monday April 16; entries sent after that will be subject to a \$10 late fee (a policy voted on by the Board in January 2014). All entries must be the artist's original creation, not a copy of another artist's work.

There will be **two new features** this year: The Best of Show and 1st & 2nd place award-winning works will be included, as possible, in an exhibition at the Chambersburg Council for the Arts, 81 North Main Street: "**FCAA Winners' Gallery**", from June 29-August 24, with a First Friday reception on Friday July 6 from 5-7pm.

Also, a new award, **The Mabel Rossman Award for Color and its Control in Paintings Using Oil or Acrylic Media**, will be chosen by our judges "to recognize an artist whose paintings in oil or acrylic media embody a knowledge of color and affirm its importance as a subject of study." This \$250 annual award is sponsored by Michael Rossman.

Members are asked to contribute to the **Franklin County Art Alliance Membership Award**, started in 2015. See the membership form on the last page: you can donate even if you're already paid your dues!—and we will take donations at the refreshment table at our meetings. The award-winning works will be chosen by our judges.

Our annual show requires many **volunteers**, so we really hope that all members will pitch in; sign-up sheets will be passed around at upcoming meetings, but if you can't get to the meeting, please call Anne Finucane at 267-1396 to volunteer. We need help with setting up the show, receiving paintings, hanging, and in particular, sitting with the show during our open hours Monday through Thursday. We always have a great turnout at the opening reception, with a beautiful tea coordinated by Brandii Klidge, and that takes lots of volunteers, too.

All members will be contacted by our telephone committee, for **contributions to the tea**. Our shows are always great — let's keep up that tradition!

#### Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor and Pastel Painting

**Council for the Arts' March-April 2018 Schedule of Classes, *continued*****Oil Painting with Ski Holm****Instructor: Ski Holm**

Whether you're a beginner looking to develop good habits or more experienced and looking to break some bad ones, this class can help. While demystifying the oil painting process, you'll work from direct observation to develop greater hand-to-eye coordination. Basically, "see it, paint it". 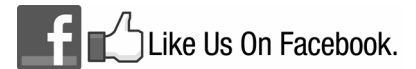
