Kate earned Bachelor of Arts degrees in both Fine Art and Biology from Mary Baldwin College in Staunton, VA, and her Master of Fine Arts at Radford University in Radford, VA. She has also worked as a Civic Justice team leader for the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services. Currently, Kate's paintings can be seen at The Foundry in downtown Chambersburg; she will be teaching a class in "The Beauty of Abstraction" at the Council for the Arts this fall.

The Alliance's **October 11 meeting** will be held at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 7PM (6:30 social time), followed by a demonstration of collage techniques by Nancy Groves. Nancy Groves earned her BFA degree in Fine Arts from Wilson College, and a degree in design drafting from the York Technical Institute in York, PA. With a long career in interior design - as well as substitute teaching - she has maintained an interest in fine art in the realm of collage. "Creativity to me is giving others a glimpse of who I am, where I've been and where I'm going," she says. "Art to me is an extension of myself, a mood, a feeling, or an experience conveyed in my work." Her collage projects start with a sketch, followed by a preliminary layout of shapes, sizes and textures. "I'm trying to slow down in a world that's rushing by me," she explains. "I feel like I'm breaking all the rules and getting away with it. It conveys to all my senses and there are no limitations!"

Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor and Pastel Painting**Instructor: Jeff Barnhart**

Using the medium and subject of your choice, the instruction in this class will focus on painting techniques and fundamentals that work regardless of medium. Students may work in oil, acrylic, watercolor, pastel or pen & ink. Jeff will offer occasional demos & lots of personal instruction. Previous experience in drawing or painting is recommended.

We will start with how to get the pictures from the camera and into the program, then on to using the Development Module to adjust Exposure, Contrast, Highlights, and other settings to get that perfect exposure. We will then learn how to create Black & White, Sepia and other Color Tones, and then add Vignettes and other Special Effects. We will learn how to make adjustments to 1 picture, or 10 at a time with just one click. You will be amazed at what you can create with this program. A laptop with Lightroom loaded is recommended.

The Beauty of Abstraction**Instructor: Kate Keely**

Join us as we spend three sessions focusing on the creative and expressive use of the Elements of Art and Principles of Design. We will discuss the similarities and differences between representational, abstract and non-objective artwork. Each class participant will experience the freedom of deriving the essence of subject matter through the subtle use of simplification, color, contrast and space. Class members will work with a wide variety of materials to generate new ideas and fresh approaches to their chosen subject matter. Demonstrations will be done in acrylic yet students are welcome to bring their own fluid media as well as canvas or paper.

Basic Digital Photography**Instructor: Eric Harbaugh**

Eric will help students understand how their digital camera works, and how to better understand the various functions. Explore the fascinating art of portrait drawing or painting! Tom will give short lessons on the structure of the face and then will give help to each student as they spend the rest of the class drawing or painting. Students should feel comfortable in whatever medium they choose since the emphasis will be on the process of creating portraits.

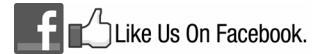

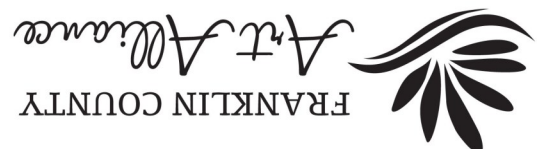
