The Alliance's September meeting will be held on Wednesday September 8 from 7-9pm (6:30 social time) at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 7pm and the program will follow, featuring a demonstration by Mechanicsburg artist Debra Tritt Kreiger. Deb is known for her beautifully drawn and painted watercolor paintings. She studied fine art at York Academy of Arts in York, PA and has pursued a full-time art career since 2000. Deb paints various subjects with ease, but nature and wildlife are her love. She works from her own photographs and explains that she can paint an animal much better if she has met him or her in person! Deb also has gained great knowledge from her experience with plein air painting, using acrylic or water-based oils along with watercolor. She has gained national and international recognition and awards for

her paintings and is a signature member of the Pennsylvania Watercolor Society, and a member of the Daily Painters of Pennsylvania, Susquehanna Valley Plein Air Painters, PA Guild of Craftsman (Yellow Breeches Chapter) and the Society of Decorative Painters. This program was originally scheduled for March 2020.

A few additional features of our September meeting: elections for Board and Officers will be held, and we will talk briefly about the Annual Exhibition tasks, **and pass around signup sheets and guidelines for artwork intake and sitting with our October show – please bring your calendar!**

The Alliance's October meeting will be held on Wednesday October 13 from 7-9pm (6:30 social time) at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 7pm and the program will follow, featuring a demonstration in oils by Marti Yeager. Marti Griffin Yeager is a full-time artist living in Fayetteville, PA. Painting is Marti's passion, and she's been working at it full-time since 1997. Her primary medium is oil, but she also works in acrylic, pastel, watercolor, drawing media, and printmaking. She enjoys sharing her passion for art with others through teaching, both group and private lessons. Over the years, Marti has won numerous awards for her paintings; and has had many solo and small group exhibits in the tri-state area and beyond, including solo exhibits at WITF's Art in the Atrium, 2019, and at Roux & Cyr International Art Gallery in Portland, Maine in 2017. In 2015, she was a featured artist in the Art Association of Harrisburg's Invitational show. Her work can often be seen at Gallery 50 in Waynesboro, PA. Marti also does commissioned work, including portraits; she will have a solo exhibit at Adams County Arts Council for the month of October 2021.

October 25-28, 2-7 PM. Entries are due by Friday Sept.10; entries sent after that will be subject to a \$10 late fee. All entries must be the artist's original creation, not a copy of another artist's work. **Find this year's entry form on page 3.**

Members are asked to contribute to the Franklin County Art Alliance Membership Award. See the membership form on the last page - you can donate even if you're already paid your dues! - and we will take donations at the refreshment table at our meetings. The award-winning work will be chosen by our judges.

Our annual show requires many volunteers, so we really hope that all members will pitch in; sign-up sheets will be passed around at September & October meetings, **but if you can't get to the meetings,** please call Anne Finucane at 267-1396 to volunteer. We need help with setting up the show, receiving paintings, hanging, and in particular, sitting with the show during our open hours Monday through Thursday. Monetary prizes will be awarded in the various categories as well as a Best of Show Award. Work may be entered on Wednesday October 13 from 6-7pm or Thursday October 14 from 9-11am. David Bottini will be judging the show on Thursday afternoon. The show will be open to the public on Friday and Saturday October 15&16 from 9am-5pm. Work should be picked up at the close of the show on Saturday. Official entry forms will be available in September from the Fulton County Library and various businesses in McConnellsburg. Shippensburg Arts Programming and Education (SHAPE) is holding an open invitational exhibit, " Woven: Willow, Reed, and Grasses" Sept.3-25 at their gallery, 19 E. King Street Shippensburg, PA This exhibit will consist of the work of artists who have utilized willow, reed, grasses, cane or other similar natural products in a woven form to create their art. Artwork can be 2D or 3D as long as it uses the materials listed above. All 2D artwork must be finished and ready to be hung on the wall. Artists may include up to 5 pieces in this exhibit with only one (1) being listed NFS. Drop off dates for the artwork are Friday, August 27 from 5-7 pm and Saturday, August 28 from 11-2. Chambersburg's artists' co-op, The Foundry Art Market, now in its 5th year at 100 South Main Street, continues to welcome applications from new artists. Annual membership fee is just \$180 per year plus a \$25 application fee which is applied to overall yearly cost upon acceptance. Commission is 40% on sales, but artists can receive lower commission rates if they choose to fulfill workshare hours: 4 hours per month = 35% commission; 8 hours per month = 30% commission, 12 hours per month = 20% commission. The annual fee goes toward overhead costs of paying rent, utilities, insurance, etc., and commission helps cover day-to-day costs of sales, like swipe fees, promotion, administrative work, etc. Visit www.FoundryArtMarket.com and scroll down under Home, or better yet, stop by and meet a Foundry Artist. Many are members of the Art Alliance who enjoy the networking and collaborative aspects of Foundry membership – and having lots of their work in a gallery with a growing audience. The shop is a busy place, open Friday through Sunday 12noon-4pm, with additional hours during the holidays!

The Washington Studio School: Until life drawing is back in person – and even after - The Washington Studio School is offering virtual figure-drawing sessions in conjunction with the DC Art Model Collective (DCAMC).

You will be surprised at how rewarding drawing from an online model can be: it is not at all like drawing a figure from a photograph! Find the registration link below in addition to a link with a variety of figure-drawing sessions offered by the DCAMC. 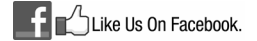
