The Alliance's May meeting will be held on Wednesday May 10 from 7-9pm (6:30 social time) at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 7pm and the program will follow, featuring a demonstration in oils by artist Robyn Jacobs. Robyn earned her BFA degree in painting at Temple University. After starting out in pastels, she moved exclusively to oils, focusing on landscapes inspired by her local countryside, mostly Littlestown, Gettysburg and Northern Maryland. Her work has become more abstracted in past years, but she credits Roger Anliker, one of the teachers at Temple, for her interest in composition: he would not accept assignments with "boring" horizon lines! She also enjoys keeping the viewer's eye moving around the canvas as if it were a maze. Robyn's program will focus in part on a technique called the "dead layer" technique which she will demonstrate on a portrait she's doing on commission. She will bring along a landscape and a flower painting, as examples of how the technique can be used with other subjects. "Composition, color and texture are what's important," Robin says, "and the subject is the fun bit!"

An election for Officers and Board members will also be held at the May meeting.

Chambersburg Foundry Art Market will present **Plein Air Chambersburg** on Saturday September 9th in downtown Chambersburg. \$2000 in awards will be presented by Judge Beth Bathe (www.bethbathe.com) .

Location: Chambers Fort Park, North Main Street.

Suggested painting subjects include North Square Farmers Market, waterfall, water-wheel, log cabin, Japanese Garden at the Old Jail, Streamside Gazebo at the Tower at Falling Spring, and the historic cemetery of Falling Spring Presbyterian Church.

Artists should plan to bring their own easel and all equipment needed. Artists are welcome to explore the area and plan their work in advance, but must begin with blank canvas/paper, stamped at check-in. Artists will have 4 hours to create their plein air art piece/s and return to the registration area with their work and their easel, and one hour to prepare for display and judging.

- 7:30am-8:30am Sign-in, surface stamping and same-day registration at Chambers Fort Park, located beside 33 North Main Street, Chambersburg. (Rainsite: Council for the Arts, 103 North Main Street)
- 8:30am-12:30pm Quick Draw Competition, with artists painting within 2 blocks of Chambers Fort Park: map provided.
- 12:30-1:30 Lunch and prep time: artists bring work and easel for display to Chambers Fort Park. Artwork must be finished and ready for hanging. Artwork must be labeled with the tag provided at check-in.

- 1:30-2:30 Judging at Chambers Fort Park.
- 2:30-3:30 Award Ceremony, Reception, Exhibit and Sale at Chambers Fort Park.

"One great advantage to displaying your work in a library is that a great many people will see it who may not go to an art gallery, so you get exposure to a wider audience," she explains. 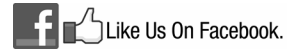
