Sarah Kersting, Howard's Art & Frames

The Alliance's March meeting will be held on Saturday March 9 from 1-3pm (12:30 social time) at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 1 pm and the program will follow, featuring a program on framing your art by Sarah Kersting and David Monet of Howard's Art & Frames in Hagerstown. Sarah Kersting is the 4th owner and operator of Howard's Art & Frames, which was established in 1941. She has been custom framing for 16 years, was trained by a Master Certified Picture Framer, and has taken many courses to further her knowledge of framing and preservation techniques. Sarah also has her Bachelor's degree in Photography. David Monet has been framing for a total of 11 years. He is multitalented and spends much of his time teaching and educating people on how to airbrush, as well as designing T-Shirts to be screen printed.

This presentation is meant to educate artists on the best methods, tools, and supplies for framing your artwork. You will be given tips on things to consider before creating your artwork that will help you save money when it's time to frame your piece. Everyone will be shown the proper methods for framing and mounting their artworks on paper, canvas, board, etc. along with some dos &

don'ts that apply to different substrates and mediums. In-person visuals of products and mounting techniques will be shown, and take-home fliers provided.

If you have a finished artwork that has you puzzled about framing, bring it along – just one, please! Sarah and David will leave time after their presentation to address specific questions.

The Alliance's April meeting will be held on Wednesday April 10 from 7-9pm, (6:30 social time) at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 7 pm and the program will follow, featuring a critique of members' works by Kate Keely. Kate currently serves as an Instructor in Visual Arts at Shippensburg University, and a Lecturer in Fine Art at Hagerstown Community College, with courses including Art Education, Art Appreciation, Art Studio and Art History. She has also taught at The Pennsylvania State University, Radford University and Frostburg State University (MD). Kate earned her Bachelor of Arts degrees in both Fine Art and Biology from Mary Baldwin College in Staunton, VA, and her Master of Fine Arts at Radford University in Radford, VA. She has also worked as a Civic Justice team leader for the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services and has taught art to State and County Prisoners. Currently, Kate's paintings can be seen at The Foundry in downtown Chambersburg.



The opening and award reception will be held at the Schmucker Art Gallery on Saturday, June 8 from 5-7pm with award announcements at 6pm: over \$2000 of awards will be made. The Toast the Artists Celebration will be held that evening from 7-9 pm at The Atrium, Gettysburg College. Basic Drawing with Rob Rock, 6 sessions, Tuesdays, 6-8 pm, March 5th through April 9th
