The Alliance's May meeting will be held on Saturday May 9 from 1-3pm (12:30 social time) at Grove Family Library (101 Ragged Edge Road South). The business meeting will begin at 1pm and the program will follow, featuring a painting demonstration by Evan Boggess. On a 34"x40" canvas, Evan will start with a gestural portrait drawing, and then add multiple layers of geometric and expressive marks, working quickly and spontaneously. This will be followed by carefully articulated realism and finished by "refining the chaos of the initial stages"! A full-time lecturer in Shepherd University's Art Department (Shepherdstown, WV) and Director of the Phaze 2 Gallery there, Evan earned his BFA at Marywood University and his MFA at the Maryland Institute College of Art. He has been honored with awards ranging from Best of Show at the Best of West Virginia Juried Exhibition, to scholarships, awards and foundation nominations. He also studied the Renaissance fresco process in Florence, Italy, and taught it at the Skowhegan School of Art in Maine!

An election for Board members will also be held at the May meeting.

Light and shadow shouldn't be afterthoughts in our paintings. Good use of light and shadow is one of the best ways to take a painting from ordinary to extraordinary. In her signature workshop *"Capturing the Light,"* Lynn will show students how to use light to design stronger compositions and bring drama to a variety of subject matter. Students will gain new skills and confidence working with shadows, light sources, creating glow, and more as they bring their work to the next level!

Each day will begin with a demo of a new painting and a new subject, for about 45 minutes. Students will work until lunch. After lunch, Lynn will do a short demo to complete the morning's project and students will have the rest of the afternoon to work on their own paintings. Lynn is always available to help and encourage, and will provide handouts, reference materials, and lots of personal attention.

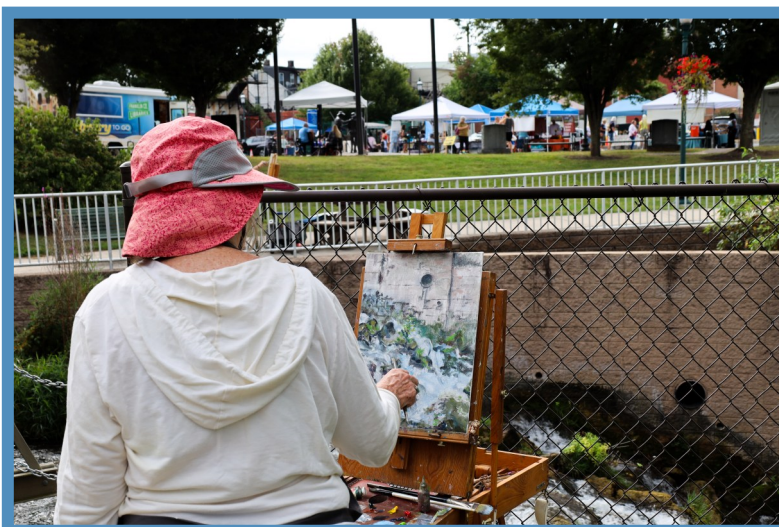
Location: Chambers Fort Park, North Main Street, Chambersburg.

Suggested painting subjects include North Square Farmers Market, waterfall, waterwheel, log cabin, Japanese Garden at the Old Jail, Streamside Gazebo at the Tower at Falling Spring, and the historic cemetery of Falling Spring Presbyterian Church. Artists should plan to bring their own easel and all equipment needed. Artists are welcome to explore the area and plan their work in advance, but must begin with blank canvas/paper, stamped at check-in. Artists will have 4 hours to create their plein air art piece/s and return to the registration area with their work and their easel, and one hour to prepare for display and judging.

Schedule:

- 7:30am-8:30am Check-in, surface stamping and same-day registration at Chambers Fort Park, located beside 33 North Main Street, Chambersburg.
- 8:30am-12:30pm Quick Draw Competition, with artists painting within 2 blocks of Chambers Park: map provided.
- 12:30-1pm Prep for judging: artists bring work and easel for display to Chambers Fort Park. Artwork must be finished and ready for hanging. Artwork must be labeled with the tag provided at check-in. Space provided for framing.
- 1-2:30pm Lunch: artists can use their \$15 voucher in one of our downtown restaurants
- 1:30-2:30 Judging at Chambers Fort Park.
- 2:30-3:30 Award Ceremony, Reception, Exhibit and Sale at Chambers Fort Park.

“I’ll try it anyway.”

Linda Best has shared with us this message from artist Will Kemp. He suggests that we use this phrase this year:

I can’t draw an accurate portrait. *“I’ll try it anyway.”*
 I don’t have all the colors for the lesson. *“I’ll try it anyway.”*
 I feel uneasy sketching outside. *“I’ll try it anyway.”*

The tries become marks, and the marks become evidence. Every sketch, every mix, every imperfect attempt quietly proves you are becoming the artist you want to be. Picture yourself a year from now with a thousand small pieces of 'artistic evidence' behind you. Growth becomes unavoidable. So step into that uneasy space this summer: this is where artistic confidence is made!

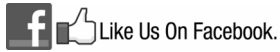
